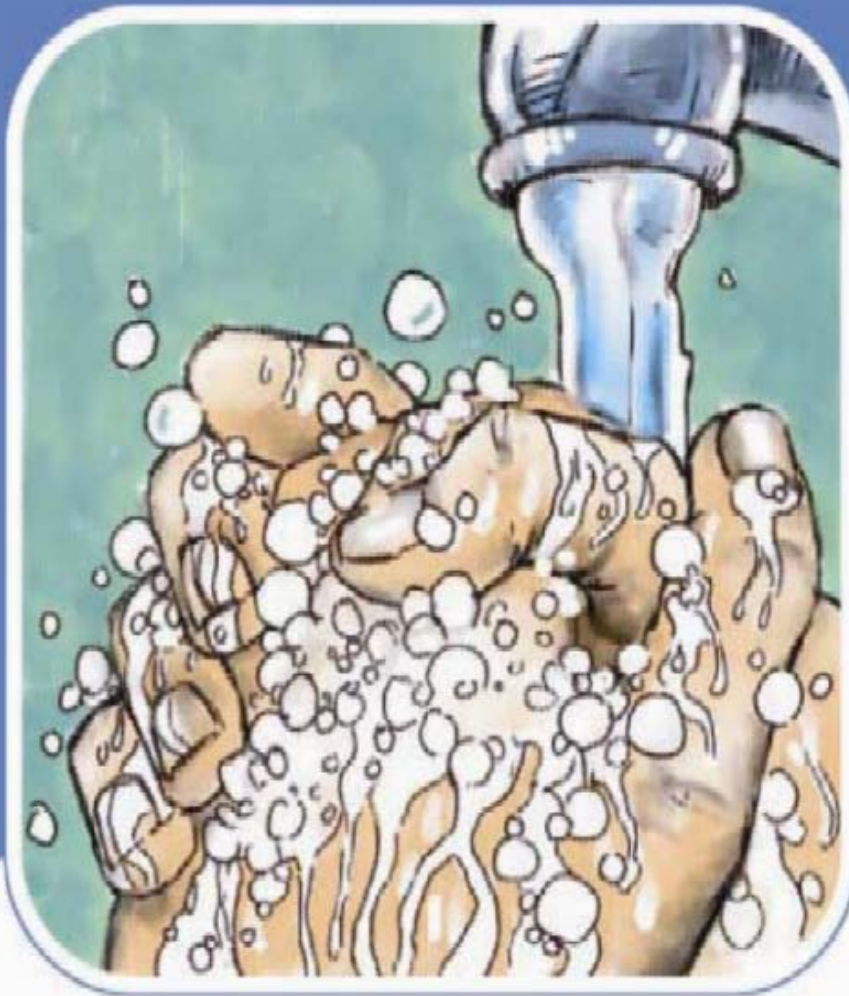


Did you wash your hands?

Discard the paper towel immediately after leaving the bathroom.
