DISPOSAL INFORMATION

- Bulky Waste:** 3 items per trash day including furniture, wood waste, textiles & mattresses. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item). **No construction waste, metals, televisions or electronics.**
- Construction Debris:** ACUA collects household renovation debris twice annually, during the Spring and Fall. Call 609-641-2832 x. 123 for details.
- Metals & Electronics:** Public Works collects metals and electronics on the 1st Wednesday of each month, regardless of your regular trash collection day. These items can be placed at the curb, separate from trash if it is on your trash day.
- Latex Paint:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. acua.com/paint
- Batteries:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to our Household Hazardous Waste drop-offs. acua.com/hhw
- Shredded Paper:** Cannot be recycled curbside, but can be brought to ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. acua.com/rcdropoffs

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

- Includes: leaves, grass, brush, branches and Christmas trees**
- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales.
 - Place yard waste in kraft bags or properly marked containers.
 - No plastic bags.
 - Kraft bags or containers should not exceed 50 lbs.
 - Brush/branches must be tied with twine.
 - Brush/branches should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter.
- Sector A:** Mill Road north to the Pleasantville border.
Sector B: Mill Road south to the Linwood border.
