CITY OF NORTHFIELD, NJ RESOLUTION NO. 110-2016

A MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A 2015 RECYCLING TONNAGE GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act, P.L. 1987, c.102, has established a recycling fund from which tonnage grant may be made to municipalities in order to encourage local source separation and recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent and the spirit of the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act to use the tonnage grants to develop new municipal recycling programs and to continue and to expand existing programs; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has promulgated recycling regulations to implement the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act; and

WHEREAS, the recycling regulations impose on municipalities certain requirements as a condition for applying for tonnage grants, including but not limited to, making and keeping accurate, verifiable records of materials collected and claimed by the municipality; and

WHEREAS, a resolution authorizing the City of Northfield to apply for such tonnage grants will memorialize the commitment of the City of Northfield to recycling and to indicate the assent of Mayor and Council of the City of Northfield to the efforts undertaken by the municipality and the requirements contained in the Recycling Act and recycling regulations; and

WHEREAS, such a resolution should designate the individual authorized to ensure the application is properly completed and timely filed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Northfield that the City of Northfield hereby endorses the submission of the 2015 recycling tonnage grant application to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and has entered into an interlocal agreement with the Atlantic County Utilities Authority for Certified Recycling Professional Services to ensure that the application is completed and properly filed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies received from the recycling tonnage grant be deposited in a dedicated recycling trust fund to be used solely for the purposes of recycling.

SUPPORTING THE CLICK IT OR TICKET MOBILIZATION OF MAY 23-JUNE 5, 2016

WHEREAS, there were 560 motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey in 2015; and

WHEREAS a large percentage of the motor vehicle occupants killed in traffic crashes were not wearing a seat belt; and

WHEREAS, use of a seat belt remains the most effective way to avoid death or serious injury in a motor vehicle crash; and

WHEREAS, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration estimates that 135,000 lives were saved by safety belt usage nationally between 1975-2000; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey will participate in the nationwide *Click It or Ticket* seat belt mobilization from May 23- June 5, 2016 in an effort to raise awareness and increase seat belt usage through a combination of high visibility enforcement and public education; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Highway Traffic Safety has set a goal of increasing the seat belt usage rate in the state from the current level of 91 percent to 93 percent; and

WHEREAS, a further increase in seat belt usage in New Jersey will save lives on our roadways;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Northfield City Council declares its support for the *Click It or Ticket* seatbelt mobilization, both locally and nationally, from May 23 – June 5, 2016 and pledges to increase awareness of the mobilization and the benefits of seat belt use.
