# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AWARDING AN EMERGENCY SEWER REPAIR CONTRACT TO LAFEYETTE UTILITY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC.

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield may award emergency contracts pursuant to Local Public Contract Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 without public advertising for bids when an emergency affecting the public health, safety or welfare of the public requires the immediate performance of services; and

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2015 the City's Sewer Department was notified of a problem with the East Revere Avenue sewer main which traverses the marsh; and

WHEREAS, after further investigation it was determined by the Sewer Supervisor that the sewer line was damaged and needed to be replaced in order to avoid discharge into the bay; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor, City Engineer, Councilman Perri and the Chief Financial Officer were made aware of the emergency on November 4, 2015 and the need for invoking N.J.S.A 40A:11-6; and

WHEREAS, all required City officials were present and determined that an emergency does exist and authorized the award of a contract for the repair of the sewer line; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to award a contract for the necessary repairs and replacement of the East Revere Avenue sewer main to Lafayette Utility Construction Company, Inc. of Pleasantville, New Jersey.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Governing Body of the City of Northfield, County of Atlantic, New Jersey as follows:

- 1. As a result of the sewer main break on November 4, 2015, an emergency existed, which threatened the public health safety of the City residents and immediate repairs were necessary to prevent the discharge of effluent into the surrounding waters.
- 2. The City approves an emergency contract with Lafayette Utility Construction Company, Inc. to effectuate the necessary repairs and replacement of the East Revere Avenue sewer main in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00.
- 3. Upon Lafayette Utility Construction Company's completion of the emergency contract, it shall be entitled to payment and the governing body of the City shall take such action as shall be required to provide for the payment of the contract price.

- 4. The Chief Financial Officer shall file the Emergency Procurement Report with the Division of Local Government Services.
- 5. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a contract and any other necessary documents with the Lafayette Utility Construction Company, Inc. to effectual the purposes of this resolution
