WHEREAS, distracted driving is a serious, life-threatening practice that is preventable; and

WHEREAS, distracted driving can result in injuries and deaths to all road users (motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists); and

WHEREAS, distracted driving occurs when drivers divert their attention away from the task of driving to focus on another activity instead; and

WHEREAS, in 2015 alone distracted driving-related crashes resulted in 3,477 deaths and 391,000 injuries on our nation's roads; and

WHEREAS, in New Jersey distracted driving was listed as a contributing circumstance in nearly 750,000 crashes between 2011-2015; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey will participate in the nationwide *Distracted Driving 2018 Crackdown* from April 1 - 21, 2018 in an effort to raise awareness and decrease driver distraction through a combination of enforcement and education; and

WHEREAS, the national slogan for the campaign is <u>UDrive. UText. UPay</u>; and

WHEREAS, a reduction in distracted driving in New Jersey will save lives on our roadways;

THEREFORE, be is resolved that the Northfield Police Department declares it's support for the *Distracted Driving 2018 Crackdown* both locally and nationally from April 1 - 21, 2018 and pledges to increase awareness of the dangers of distracted driving.

AUTHORIZING RELEASE OF PERFORMANCE GUARANTEES AND INSPECTION ESCROWS, AND WAIVER OF MAINTENANCE GUARANTEE, FOR BLOCK 42, LOTS 8 AND 9

WHEREAS the owner of Block 42, Lots 8 and 9 has requested that their Performance Bond, cash Performance Guarantee, and any remaining inspection escrow funds be released; and

WAIVER OF INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE NORTHFIELD MOTHERS' LEAGUE

WHEREAS the Northfield Mothers' League ("NML") is a 501(c)(3) non-profit group, with extremely limited resources, organized for the sole benefit of families residing in the City of Northfield; and

WHEREAS the NML has been in existence since 1932, and since that time, its members have been volunteering countless hours of their time to raise funds for local families in need, i.e. providing food, clothes, and other essentials for families in need; and

WHEREAS the NML has historically has met in the City Hall and has been the recipient of a waiver of the City's insurance requirements provided a City Employee is present at the time of said meetings; and

WHEREAS the NML has looked into changing the place of their meetings from City Hall to the City Library meeting room; and

WHEREAS the NML is requesting a waiver of the City's insurance requirements for the use of the City Library for meeting purposes and other City facilities, such as Birch Grove Park for the 2018 calendar year; and

WHEREAS for several reasons including but not limited to cost, the advancement of the social and civic well-being of the residents of the City of Northfield, the level of risk and general necessity, the Common Council of the City of Northfield is in favor of waiving the requirement that the NML provide evidence of general liability insurance provided the NML executes a hold harmless agreement acceptable to the City of Northfield;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Northfield hereby conditionally waives the requirement that the NML provide evidence of general liability insurance. Prior to use of City facilities, the NML shall execute a hold harmless agreement acceptable to the City of Northfield. This waiver is specifically limited to NML 2018 use of City facilities and shall not extend to any other user of any facility in the City of Northfield. This waiver is also specifically limited to the requirement regarding the provision of insurance and shall not extend to any other requirement of the City of Northfield which are unaffected by this Resolution.
