WHEREAS, the Bylaws of said Fund require that each municipality appoint a RISK MANAGEMENT CONSULTANT to perform various professional services as detailed in the Bylaws and;

WHEREAS, the Bylaws indicate a fee not to exceed six percent (6%) of the municipal assessment which expenditure represents reasonable compensation for the services required and was included in the City's 2018 total combined Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund assessment, which is charged against line 01-23-215-200, and;

WHEREAS, requests for proposals for Risk Management Consultant Services were advertised and one proposal was received; and

WHEREAS, Richard T. Gerber of R. T. Gerber Insurance submitted a proposal dated December 6, 2017, indicating he will provide the City of Northfield with his services as Risk Management Consultant for an annual fee of \$9,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the City's 2018 total combined Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund assessment is \$378,066.00, and the fee proposed for Mr. Gerber represents approximately 2.5% of this total.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved that the governing body of the City of Northfield does hereby appoint Richard T. Gerber of R. T. Gerber Insurance as its Risk Management Consultant, in accordance with 40A:11-5 and;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the term of said appointment shall be one year, from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the governing body is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Consultant's Agreement annexed hereto.
