- Animals currently licensed in another state must be re-licensed in the City within ninety (90) days.

All licenses expire on December 31st of each year. No dogs or cats are permitted to run at large. Owners will be subject to a fine. Northfield has a Running at Large Ordinance and a "Pooper-Scooper" Ordinance.
