

**CITY OF NORTHFIELD, NJ
ORDINANCE NO. 14-2019**

**AMENDING CHAPTER 61 OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD
MUNICIPAL CODE, ENTITLED “POLICE DEPARTMENT”**

WHEREAS, the City of Northfield is desirous of creating the position of police chaplains in the Police Department;

BE IT ORDAINED, Chapter 61, Article 1 – Creating Section 11:

By virtue of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-141 creating the honorary unpaid position of Police Chaplain in the City of Northfield Police Department. The individuals appointed to be Police Chaplains shall be an ordained clergyman in good standing in the religious body from which such person is selected. Such chaplain(s) shall become an unpaid honorary member of the municipal police department or force without rank or salary. The honorary unpaid position of Police Chaplain in the City of Northfield Police Department may be withdrawn at any time without notice required by the Council for the City of Northfield.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately after adoption.

REPEALER

All Ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent in whole or in part with the provisions contained herein are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

This Ordinance shall take effect following its advertisement, public hearing and adoption in accordance with the law.
