

**CITY OF NORTHFIELD, NJ
ORDINANCE NO. 7-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XIII F, SECTIONS 111-26.23,
111-26.25 AND 111-26.32 OF THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD CODE
ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Northfield, Atlantic County, is of the opinion that the public interest will best be served by revising §111-26.23, §111-26.25 and §111-26.32 of the Code of the City of Northfield;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Northfield as follows:

1. Chapter 111, Section 26.23, of the Code of the City of Northfield is hereby amended as follows (deleted language is ~~stricken~~; additional language is underlined):

§ 111-26.23

Parking regulations; handicapped parking.

A. (i) All vehicles must park in designated areas and between the lines provided.

(ii) As authorized by and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:4-197(g), all vehicles shall comply with any and all signage on or upon the Northfield Community School property regulating the parking of vehicles in any manner, including but not limited to location regulations and time regulations.

§ 111-26.25

Through streets; stop intersections.

A. Through streets. The following streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as through streets. Stop signs shall be installed and complied with by operators of vehicles on the near right side of each street intersecting the through street, except where yield signs are provided for in the designation:

Name of Street	Limits
Northfield Community School Drive	Entire length

B. No change.

§ 111-26.32

Violations and penalties.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey statute, every person convicted of a violation of this article or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than ~~\$200~~ ~~\$27~~, payable through the Violations Bureau of the City of Northfield, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days, or both.

2. All Ordinances or portions thereof which are inconsistent in whole or in part with the provisions contained herein are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistency.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect following its advertisement, public hearing and adoption in accordance with the law.
