WHEREAS, this will stimulate further growth and have a sustaining impact on the County's communities and the County as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the ACIA will, on behalf of and in conjunction with selected municipalities, utilize its project management experience, call upon the expertise of seasoned professional consultants and employ its expansive powers to create new, and advanced stalled, development and redevelopment projects with the goal of generating ratables, creating permanent and temporary jobs, improving and constructing infrastructure, and eliminating or preventing blight; and
