AMENDED SECOND AMENDED AGREEMENT FOR SHARED MUNICIPAL COURT FOR THE MUNICIPALITIES OF THE CITY OF LINWOOD AND THE CITY OF NORTHFIELD

THIS AMENDED SECOND AMENDED AGREEMENT is made this _____ day of January, 2019;

BY AND BETWEEN the CITY OF LINWOOD, a Municipality duly formed, organized and existing in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, located in the County of Atlantic, with municipal offices located at 400 Poplar Avenue, Linwood, New Jersey 08221 (hereinafter "Linwood") and the CITY OF NORTHFIELD, a Municipality duly formed, organized and existing in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, located in the County of Atlantic, with municipal offices located at 1600 Shore Road, Northfield, New Jersey 08225 (hereinafter "Northfield").

WHEREAS, the Second Amended Agreement for Shared Municipal Court for the Municipalities of the City of Linwood and the City of Northfield was entered into on January 3, 2019; and

WHEREAS, subsequent thereto the Municipal Prosecutor increased his annual salary by the sum of \$3,400.00 to be divided equally between Linwood and Northfield, which will result in a net increase in the amount of \$1,700 that the City of Linwood will pay to the City of Northfield; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Second Amended Agreement to reflect the increase of the Municipal Prosecutor's salary and the 50% reimbursement thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual promises made herein and the mutual benefits to be derived herefrom, the Parties, intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows:

6. Management; Budget:

- A. Each Municipality shall share general management authority of Municipal Court employees, although these employees shall be employed by and paid under the salary ordinance of the City of Northfield. In addition, the Municipalities shall confer and reach agreement on personnel issues including, but not limited to hiring, termination, salary, work assignments and adherence to established policies insofar as they impact and relate to the shared Courts.
- B. In consideration for the City of Northfield employing and paying salaries to the Municipal Court Judge, the Court Administrator, the Court Deputy Clerk, the Prosecutor and the Public Defender, as well as incurring

and paying other related costs to maintain its Court facilities for use by both Municipalities, the City of Linwood shall pay the following annual fees to the City of Northfield on an annual basis:

2018 Annual Fee: \$131,045 (2.5% increase over 2017)
2019 Annual Fee \$137,021 (2.5% increase plus one-half of 2019 Municipal Court Judge Salary increase plus one-half of 2019 Municipal Prosecutor Salary increase)

All other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged.
