ACCUMULATED ABSENCE

WHEREAS, NJAC 5:30-15 establishes rules that govern how local government units manage and finance compensation for accumulated absence time for their respective employees, and

WHEREAS, accumulated absence includes any sick days, vacation days, personal days or other absence time authorized as part of an employer agreement, which is not used by the employee during the allowed period and which is permitted to accumulate over time to the benefit of the employee, and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that the funds and authority exists to pay the total accumulated absence, as per the attached schedule, to Arthur Faden who will retire from the service of the City effective March 31, 2013. Terminal leave will commence on December 17, 2012 and cease on March 31, 2013, utilizing accumulated sick time in the amount of \$30,533.58; and

WHEREAS, the attached certification and documentation are presented to comply with the rules and regulations established by the Local Finance Board.

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 154-2012, ADOPTING THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 48 (N.J.S.A. 52:14.17.38) UNDER WHICH A PUBLIC EMPLOYER MAY AGREE TO PAY FOR THE STATE HEALTH BENEFITS PROGRAM COVERAGE OF CERTAIN RETIREES

BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the City of Northfield, County of Atlantic, State Health Benefits Plan (SHBP) ID Number 0870-00, hereby elects to adopt the provisions of N.J.S.A. 52:14-17.38 and adhere to the rules and regulations promulgated by the State Health Benefits Commission and School Employees' Health Benefits Commission to implement the provisions of that law.
- 2. This resolution affects employees as shown on the attached Chapter 48 Resolution Addendum.
- 3. It is effective on the 1st day of November, 2012
- 4. We are aware that adoption of this resolution does not free us of the obligation to pay for post-retirement medical benefits of retirees or employees who qualified for those payments under any Chapter 88 Resolution or Chapter 48 Resolution adopted previously by this governing body.
- 5. We agree that this Resolution will remain in effect until properly amended or revoked with the SHBP.
- 6. We recognize that, while we remain in the SHBP, we are responsible for providing the payment for post-retirement medical coverage as listed in the attached Chapter 48 Resolution Addendum for all employees who quality for this coverage while this Resolution is in force.
- 7. We understand that we are required to provide the Division of Pensions and Benefits complete copies of all contracts, ordinances, and resolutions that detail post-retirement medical payment obligations we undertake. We also recognize that we may be required to provide the Division with information needed to carry out the terms of this Resolution.
